



LICENSED CLINICAL SOCIAL WORKER

SUMMARY/OBJECTIVE

The Licensed Clinical Social Worker reports to the Chief Medical Officer and is responsible for ensuring that the medically related emotional and social needs of EUI's patients are met and maintained on an individual basis in accordance with policies and procedures, and current federal, state and local standards, guidelines and regulations.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

1. Develops a comprehensive social history and psychosocial assessment that includes the patient's problems, strengths and preferences, including cultural, religious, and ethnic background and implications for the care plan.
2. Orients patients and families to EUI, its services, its service limitations and patients' rights.
3. Includes patients and families in care planning, encouraging their attendance at care conferences.
4. Completes mandatory documentation within timelines established by applicable regulations.
5. Empowers patients and encourages their choice in matters affecting them, demonstrating receptive attitudes and sensitivity to choices based on racial, cultural and ethnic heritage, and sexual orientation.
6. Ameliorates emotional distress of patients and families.
7. Provides linkage with appropriate community resources by maintaining knowledge of other systems, making referrals and identifying unmet needs.
8. Provides patients and families with crisis management services.
9. Participates as a member of the social service self-directed work team and the case management team.

SUPERVISORY RESPONSIBILITY

This position has minimal supervision responsibilities.

Position Type and Expected Hours of Work:

This is a full-time position, and hours of work and days are Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Occasional evening and weekend work may be required as job duties demand.



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Required Education and Experience:

1. Master's Degree in social work from an accredited school.
2. Licensed in the State of Florida.
3. Minimum of 3 years' experience.

Preferred Education and Experience:

1. Two (2) years of supervisory social work experience in a community health care setting, working directly with individuals.

Additional Eligibility Qualifications:

1. Must be able to function independently and have flexibility, personal integrity and the ability to work effectively with patients, staff and support agencies.
2. Must be able to relate to and work with ill, disabled, elderly, emotionally upset and at times hostile people within the community.
3. Must possess the ability to make independent decisions when circumstances warrant such action.

Other Duties:

Duties, responsibilities and activities may change at any time with or without notice.
